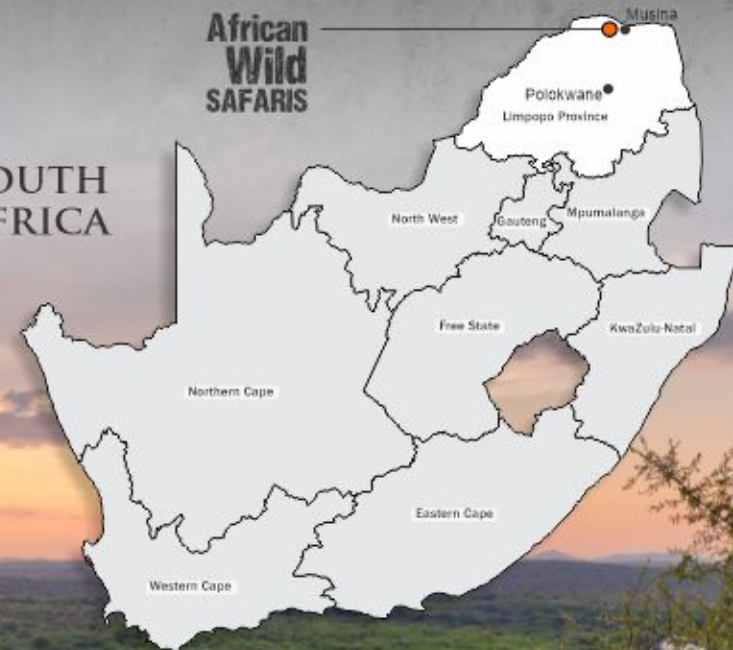

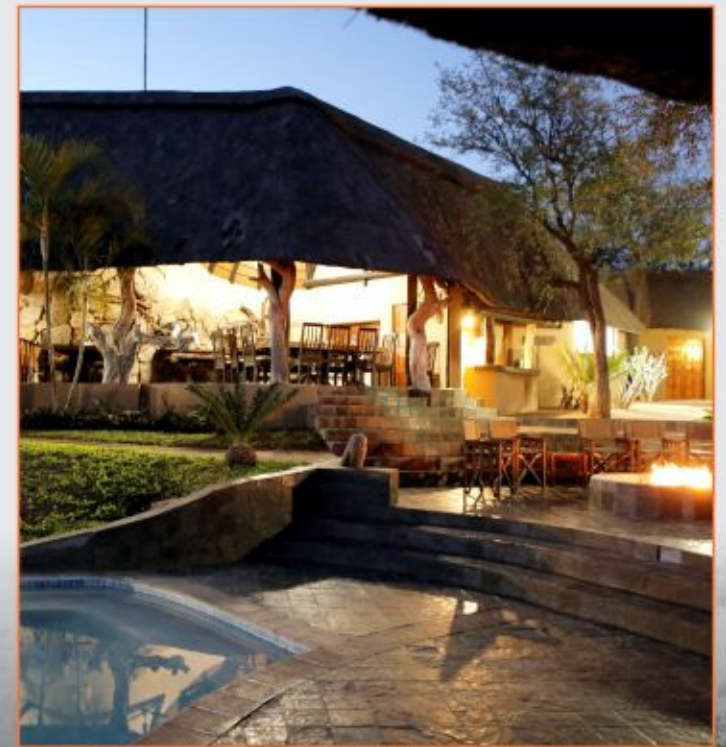

## Passports/Visas

A valid passport is needed. South Africa requires no Visa.

## Transport

Your trip fee includes pick up and drop off at the international airport closest to your safari destination: **South Africa - Polokwane, Limpopo**

## Insurance

Clients are responsible for their own Insurance and Medical cover.

## Trophies

Your trophies will be marked, salted, and field prepared prior to being sent to a taxidermist. African Wild Safaris will prepare all taxidermy documentation and arrangements.

## Firearms & Ammunition

Bring a bolt action or a double rifle (muzzle loaders are also welcome). For Buffalo, Rhino and Elephant- a minimum caliber of 375 or higher is recommended. For Lion, Leopard, Antelope and other medium game - a caliber of 300 or 30-06 will be sufficient.

For dangerous game - 20 full metal-jacket cartridges as well as 20 soft-point cartridges are required. For medium game, you will need at least 40 soft-point cartridges.

## Firearms & Ammunition Cont.

Fit your rifle with a good quality scope with variable power: 1.5-6 x 42, 2.2-9 x 42 or the like.

## Gun Fees

The import of hunting weapons to South Africa and Zimbabwe is free (declaration at customs upon arrival suffices). The legislation governing international flights demands that rifles and ammunition be transported in lockable cases with ammunition packed separately. It is advisable to pack the ammo in an ammo case in your check-in luggage. This is also more cost effective, as the cost of checking in ammo packed in a separate ammo case is \$200 per flight.

## Gun Permits

When booking, specify the animals you wish to hunt. A handling fee of R500 is charged at the airport checking the rifles in. All hunters from countries which are signatory to CITES Convention must bring a photocopy or their

original CITES permit for Leopard, Elephant, Crocodile, Lion and Hippopotamus. CITES permits can be obtained from the Federal Wildlife Permit Office.

## Bow Hunting

If you plan on using a bow, please let us know in advance so that we can prepare. No permits are required for bow hunting. Best season for bow hunting August through to October.

## Average Temperature

- February to April – 50°F to 85°F
- May to August – 40°F to 65°F
- September to October – 50°F to 85°F

## Terms & Conditions

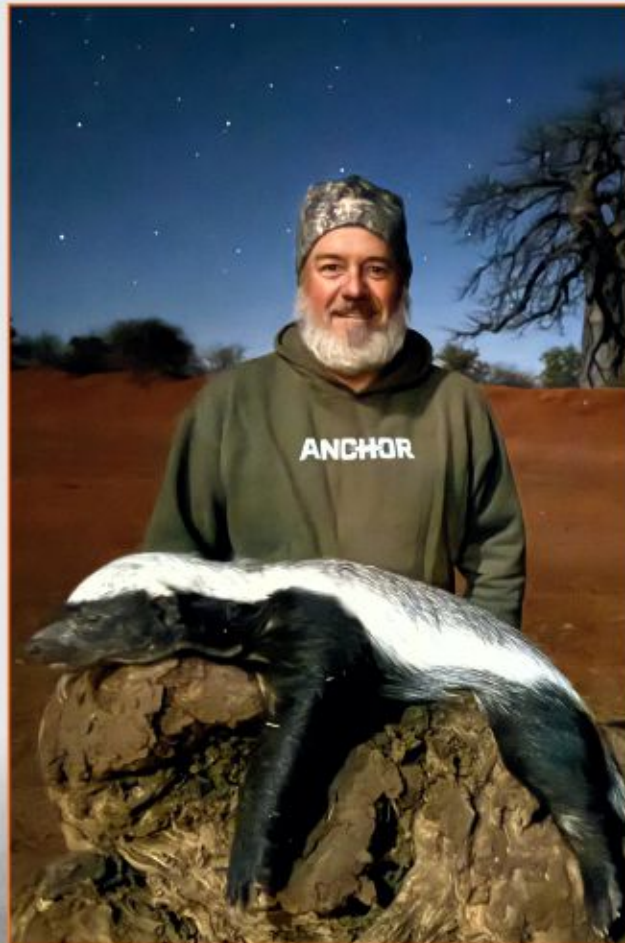














# THE MASK SLAM

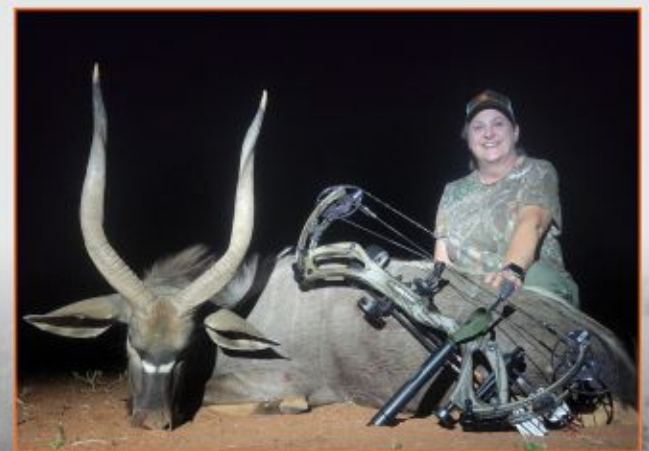

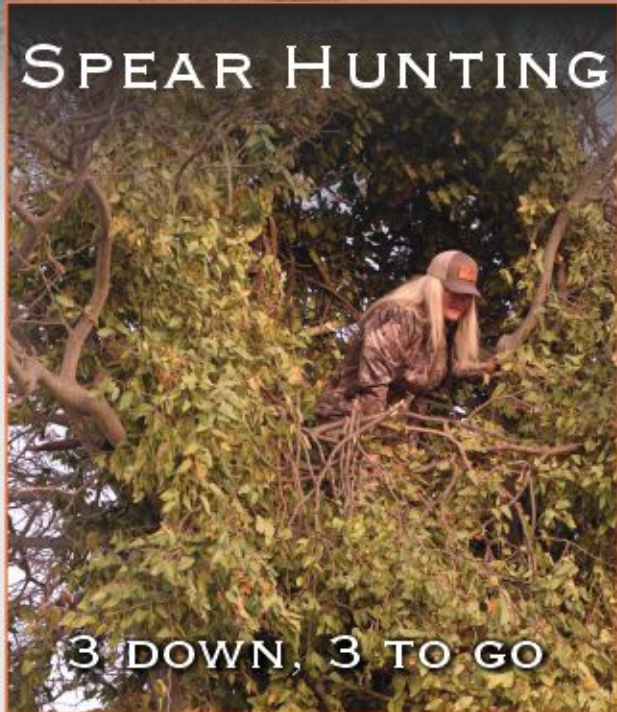

# CONSERVATION

Although hunting is our main activity, we also pride ourselves in caring for the Protected and Endangered species.

Any Ranch Owner will never turn a blind eye on an animal which needs care, weather it is rescuing and releasing leopards caught in snares or hosting a safe facility for the release of our beloved pangolins, to treatment of Specially Protected species like white rhino.

This Kori Bustard (the largest of its kind), was found caught in the fence. It had a severe injuries to its back and leg and would never be able to walk or fly again. Although Dian took care of it for 3 weeks, it sadly succumb to it's injuries. You have to try, whatever the case and the circumstances. Every heartbeat is a chance of survival.

## **Freedom at Last**

Pizulu came to Leadwood Ranch recently. He was confiscated out of 'the trade'. Pangolin are currently the most trafficked species hence great care is taken to securely rehabilitate and release them - each life matters. He was fitted the necessary tracking equipment in order for his rehabilitation and move about to be monitored and data to be captured.

After 9 months of monitoring him the rehabilitation team was satisfied that he had settled in his new area. Consequently all tracking devices were removed and Pizulu is now the first successful release in Limpopo. Great work from the rehabilitation team that save no time no cost and no expense to commit themselves to the survival of this special species.

*Our Veterinarian attending to a female leopard that was caught in a snare a few miles from us. She was relocated here and adapted easily.*
